# Course Description

- This course provides an introduction to creating a Web page using HTML. Students will learn how to design a Web page, add animation, graphics and make changes to the page. They will submit their Web pages to the Instructor at the end of the course.

- Determine the goals and create an appropriate Web page outline.
- Maximize efficient use of a browser.
- Use HTML to build a simple Web page
- Use an HTML editor.
- Submit Web page to the Instructor.

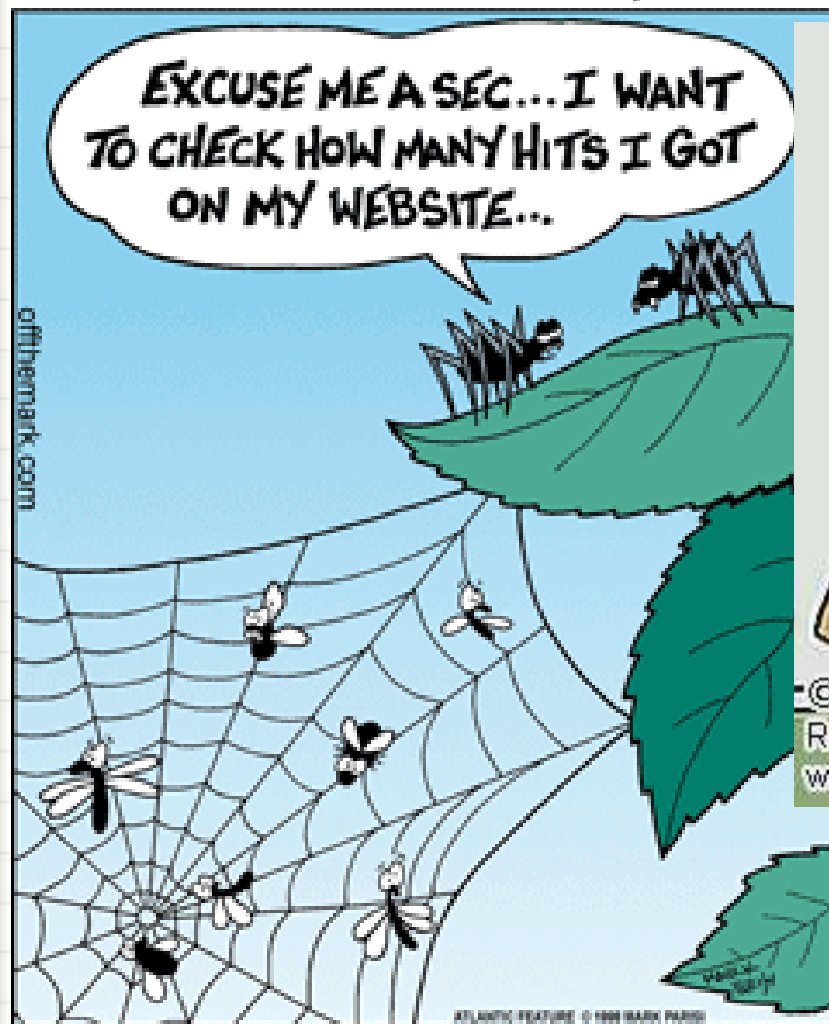
